WEARING YOUR SILK SCARF: BANDEAU STYLE



First lay the scarf flat (fig 1).

Fold both corners into the centre. They should overlap slightly. (fig 2).

Repeat this step on each of the two folded sides to meet in the middle (fig 3).

Then fold one side on top of the other to form a headband (fig 4).


The headband can be worn tied or untied. For the untied version, the middle of the headband is placed at the front of the neck, the corners are crossed behind the nape, at the base of the neck, and folded in front of the shoulders. For the tied version follow the same steps and then secure with a knot.

WEARING YOUR SILK SCARF: TRIANGLE STYLE







First lay the scarf flat (fig 1) and join the opposite corners to form a triangle (fig 2). Fold the base of the triangle back on itself (fig 3) with the corner pointed down and the wide side against your neck. Cross the two opposite corners behind the nape and adjust them over the shoulders. They can be left free or tied with a simple knot.
